Message from the HOA Board of Directors

SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT AT COMMON AREA: In the April Board meeting, the Board voted to approve the use of Digital Witness, a company specializing in surveillance equipment and monitoring. Digital Witness has installed new full-color, motion-sensored cameras around the pool and tennis court areas. As part of the contract, Digital Witness provides a service where the Board members and our management company can access the cameras from off-site to monitor activity in these areas. Digital Witness will also provide reports on activity, as well as maintaining and updating all the equipment.

Kid's Korner

Tissue Paper Flowers

Supplies Needed: Several sheets of tissue paper and green pipe cleaners

1. Cut 4 to 6 pieces of tissue paper into about 8"x10" (exact size is not necessary).
2. Put the paper in a pile and fold like an accordion.
3. Tie the center of the folded paper with one green pipe cleaner (or twist tie).
4. Gently pull each piece of paper towards the top center of the flower, separating each piece of paper from the others.



Recipe of the Month

Grape Salad

4 lbs. of seedless grapes (rinsed & dried)
8 oz. of cream cheese
8 oz. sour cream
1/2 cup sugar
1 tsp. vanilla
Brown sugar
Pecans

Soften cream cheese and mix with sour cream. Mix in sugar and vanilla. Add grapes. Stir together and pour into serving container. Sprinkle brown sugar over to cover top and then sprinkle on the pecans.
