

Meadows@Northcrest Pool Rules(Updated 6/30/10)

- Pool hours are 9:00 am to 8:00 pm Monday-Friday and 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Saturday and Sunday.
- Pool use is for residents and their guests only. Limit 2 guests per resident. Resident must be at least 18 years of age to have guests.
- Photo ID required for entry.
- Residents and guests must sign in.
- Residents must use their own key card for entry. A resident may not be the guest of another resident.
- For the health, safety and welfare of children under 16 years of age they may not swim unattended. An attendant must be at least 18 years of age.
- Residents and their guests are expected to clean up their own trash. Cigarette butts should be disposed of properly.
- All persons using pool do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- Anytime there is lightening or thunder is heard everyone is to be out of the pool.
- Solo swimming is prohibited.
- Shower before entering pool.
- Non potty trained children will wear rubber pants/swim diapers while in the pool.
- Persons with open sores or cuts are not permitted in the pool.
- Persons with infectious or communicable diseases, which can be transmitted by water, are prohibited from the pool.
- No alcohol allowed.
- No diving.
- No running or boisterous conduct.
- No glass allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.
- No metal containers, sharp objects or hazardous materials allowed in the pool area.
- No gum chewing in the pool.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- No spitting, spouting of water or blowing the nose etc. in the pool.
- No unsupervised children allowed in restrooms.
- No skateboards, skates, rollerblades or bicycles allowed inside the pool fence.
- Pool monitor on duty will be responsible for enforcing all pool rules.
- Infraction of any pool rules may result in the suspension of pool privileges.
